### WHAT IS TRADITIONAL JAPANESE ACUPUNCTURE & MOXIBUSTION? HOW IS IT DIFFERENT TO TRADITIONAL CHINESE MEDICINE?

Traditional Japanese Medicine is Traditional Chinese Medicine, with some modifications that have developed over the 1500 year history of Chinese Medicine in Japan. All the acupuncture points, meridians, diagnostic approaches, and theories are predominantly derived from the great Chinese acupuncture classics, so in a sense it is like a close cousin to Traditional Chinese Medicine.

### WHAT CHARACTERISES TRADITIONAL JAPANESE ACUPUNCTURE & MOXIBUSTION?

Traditional Japanese Acupuncture & Moxibustion is special in the way the hands, needles, heart, and moxa are used in an integrated manner in order to achieve clinical outcomes through treatments that maximise patient comfort and enjoyment. It is said that the patient should feel more of the practitioner and less of the needle.

### IS IT TRUE THAT JAPANESE-STYLE ACUPUNCTURISTS ONLY USE VERY FINE NEEDLES?

Not at all! While Japanese-style acupuncturists quite routinely use fine needles, they also use thick needles when appropriate. Learning Japanese-style acupuncture skills includes learning how to select appropriate needle width for the particular acupuncture point, the patient type, as well as the syndrome to be treated.
